

Proposal for: Eviction

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The Problem:

There may be a time when requests will be made for an eviction of a member.
A formal process needs to be in place that benefits the community.

Plan:

Arbitration shall be used to resolve the matter.

If not resolved, a formal consensus vote of adult voting members shall be held, with consensus being 80% of those that vote. There must be a quorum of at least ten voters.

A 24 hour notice must be given prior to the voting.

Upon eviction, that person's unused food and personal possessions shall be refunded.

When notified of the eviction, that person has 24 hours to leave.

Cost: \$0

Pros:

It is a pre-designed formal process that acts fast yet allows for cooling down.

Prevents lynching or mutiny.

Requires input from all members.

Cons:

Could be decided by the Leadership Council.

Responsible Party: Moral Leader or his assigns.
