<u>Instructions for Fish Antibiotics in Humans</u> <u>PensacolaPreppers</u>

Ampicillin

Urinary Tract Infections

Adult Dosage: 500 milligrams, 4 times a day. Duration: 3 days.

Amoxicillin

Ear Infections

Bronchitis (treat and if no improvement seen change to Keflex) Strep Throat (treat and if no improvement seen change to Keflex) Skin Infections (if not bad)

Adult Dosage: 500 milligrams, 2 times a day. Duration: 7 days.

Keflex

Note: This is much stronger than amoxicillin and can result in severe diarrhea. Wherever possible, use amoxicillin first. Use Keflex as last resort!

Bronchitis

Stomach bugs (diarrhea and/or vomiting)

Ear Infections

Adult Dosage: 500 milligrams, 2 to 4 times a day, with food. Duration: 3 to 7 days.

Metronidozale

For reactions to antibiotics, especially Keflex.

If taking antibiotics and you get severe diarrhea then take Metronidozale with the anti-biotic to counter the bad side affects of the anti-biotic.

Some Vaginal problems (bacterial)

Adult Dosage: 250 milligrams 4 times a day. Duration: 7-14 days

Do not drink alcohol.

Penicillin:

Mild Infections, skin, cuts, gun shots

Note: If redness creeps past mark (grows), switch to Keflex or something else.

Adult Dosage: 500 milligrams, 4 times per day. Duration: 7 - 10 days.

One hour before meal or two hours after meal.
